 - 1 Problems out but nothing complete
 - 2 Problems out and complete with work shown.
- Bell Ringer Presentation of Wild Math Problems presented individually.
 - 0 Did not present
 - 10 Presented but relied heavily on Mr. Schaben to help or work hard to read and unorganized.
 - 20 Presented with work shown. Expect to present every other week. Mistakes are encouraged for discussion.
- Approx. 15 practice lessons per guarter worth 2 pts kept in an organized binder/notebook.
 - 0 not turned in or no work shown 0% Lowest Grade you can receive on a test
 - 1 not complete / work missing 25% Lowest Grade you can receive on a test
 - 2 Complete with work shown 50% Lowest Grade you can receive on a test
 - Lesson folder due the day before Exams for Grade Check/Interview
- Assessment rubric for each of approx. 15 lessons per guarter worth 100 pts each
 - Exams can only be retaken if homework is complete with work shown after a study session
 - Retakes are allowed one day after a tutoring/practice session.
 - Retakes have to be done within two weeks of the initial test.
- Semester One Final (100 Points) * Cannot be retaken or 1 additional AOPS Course Green
- Semester Two Final (100 points) *Cannot be retaken or 1 additional AOPS Course Green
- AOPS Order (PreAlgebra, Algebra, Geometry, Your choice) If you had me last year you will do Geometry and either Number Theory or Counting and Probability in that order.
- A blue will replace an orange in AOPS. Mr. Schaben will explain what this means.

Grades for each Semester of Highschool Credit will be divided among the following categories:

- <u>1st Semester</u>: Quarter 1 = 45% / Quarter 2 = 45% / 1st Semester Test = 10%

- <u>2nd Semester</u>: Quarter 3 = 45% / Quarter 4 = 45% / 2nd Semester Test = 10%
