Test: There will be one test per unit.

Extra Credit: Will be given occasionally.

Important!!

A Semester Grade of <u>below</u> a 70% will result in you having to **RETAKE** this course **next school year**.

**A semester grade is your Q1 grade (45%), Q2 grade (45%), and semester final (10%) grade averaged.

If you do not pass both semesters of pre-algebra you will not go on to Algebra 1A or Algebra 1 with the rest of your class.

Your teacher (Mrs. Deal) is the person who will recommend you to move to Algebra 1 (1 year) or Algebra 1 A and B (2 years) OR NOT. That is entirely up to you.

You will be **assessed** for proper course placement during Quarter 1, so please do your **best work**.
