

**MATH ELL T1 - Mrs. Malcom
2025-2026 Syllabus**

Objective: Students will learn math concepts and math vocabulary in the English language.

Classroom Expectations: Students are expected to behave in a **RESPECTFUL** manner within the classroom and school wide.

*Students will demonstrate **RESPECT** by following school rules and showing kindness towards adults and other students. Students will also be respectful of school property.

Consequences:

Any disruptive behavior or disrespectful language will result in the following consequences:

*1 verbal warning: You will be asked once to change your behavior.

*Detention before or after school for 30 minutes. 30 minutes will be added each day until you serve the detention. (Accumulating to 2 hours)

*You have 4 days to serve your detention before I ask the office to add your name to the ISS list. After your ISS day you must serve a 1 hour detention with me.

These are examples of behaviors that may result in a detention: being tardy for class, using disrespectful words in any language, using your phone, talking or making noises during instruction time, putting on makeup, leaving the room without permission, cheating, or using your Ipad inappropriately.

Ipad Use: The Ipad you use in this class belongs to the school!

This means that it should only be used for educational purposes! Any inappropriate use of the Ipad may result in it being taken away for a time.

Please remember to charge your ipad at home, but also bring the charger to school everyday.

Phones, Smart Watches and Earbuds:

The school phone and earbud rules will be enforced. If you wear a smart watch please take it off and put it in your backpack during this class.

Food and Drink:

Please do not bring coffee or soda. You may only bring water to drink. Your water bottle must have a lid. You may bring food only for yourself.

Semester Test Grade:
