Objective:

Students will learn how to read, write, and speak in English through the study of vocabulary and concepts of Earth Science and Life Science.

Classroom Expectations: Students are expected to behave in a **RESPECTFUL** manner within the classroom and school wide.

*Students will demonstrate **RESPECT** by following school rules and showing kindness towards adults and other students. Students will also be respectful of school property.

Consequences:

Any disruptive behavior or disrespectful language will result in the following consequences:

*1 verbal warning: You will be asked once to change your behavior.

*Detention before or after school for 30 minutes. 30 minutes will be added each day until you serve the detention. (Accumulating to 2 hours)

*You have 4 days to serve your detention before I ask the office to add your name to the ISS list. After your ISS day you must serve a 1 hour detention with me.

Some behaviors that can result in a detention are: being tardy for class, sleeping, using disrespectful words in any language, using your phone during class, talking or making noises, putting on makeup, leaving the room without permission, cheating, or using your Ipad inappropriately (gaming, YouTube, etc).

Ipad Use:

The Ipad you use in this class belongs to the school!

This means that it should only be used for educational purposes while you are at school. Any inappropriate use of the Ipad at home or at school will result in it being taken away from you for a time.

Phones and Smart Watches:

School phone and earbud rules will be enforced. If you wear a smart watch please take it off and put it in your backpack during this class.

Food and Drink:

Please do not bring coffee or soda to class. You may bring water, but your drink bottle must have a lid. **You should not have open drinks near your Ipad.**

You may bring a small snack for yourself.

- Vocabulary Quiz 30%
- Vocabulary Notebook 15%

Semester Test Grade:

1st Semester: Quarter 1- 45%, Quarter 2- 45%, 1st Semester Test -10%

2nd Semester: Quarter 3 -45%, Quarter 4-45%, 2nd Semester Test - 10%

An assignment is due the day after it was assigned to receive full credit.

* Late work will be accepted, however 20 points will be deducted from the grade. I will not accept late work after 10 days.
