

**Overview:**

Introduction to Family and Consumer Sciences is a one-semester course. This is an introductory course open to 9th and 10th grade students that covers topics related to Family and Consumer Sciences.

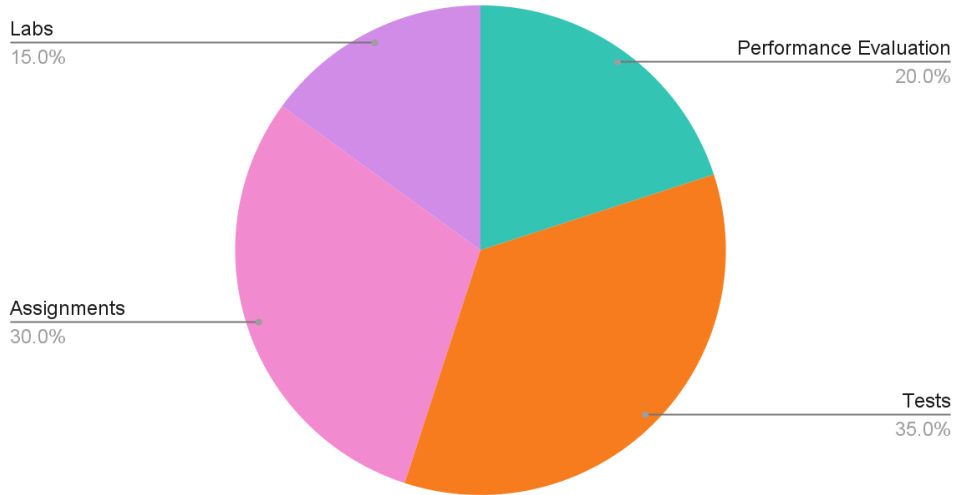
**Homework Policy:**
