- Approx. 5-10 practice problems per day worth 10 pts. Handed in at the end of every period. No technology used. Work together and as a group to solve and present solutions
 - 0 not turned in or no work shown - 0% Lowest Grade you can receive on a test
 - 5 not complete / work missing - 25% Lowest Grade you can receive on a test
 - 10 Complete with work shown - 50% Lowest Grade you can receive on a test
- Assessment rubric for each Lesson approx. 15 lessons per quarter worth 100 pts each
 - Exams can only be retaken if homework is complete **with work shown** after a study session
 - Retakes are allowed one day after a tutoring/practice session.
 - Retakes have to be done within two weeks of the initial test.
- Semester One Final (100 Points) ***Cannot be retaken**
- Semester Two Final (100 points) ***Cannot be retaken**

Grades for each Semester of Highschool Credit will be divided among the following categories:

– 1st Semester: Quarter 1 = 45% / Quarter 2 = 45% / 1st Semester Test = 10%

– 2nd Semester: Quarter 3 = 45% / Quarter 4 = 45% / 2nd Semester Test = 10%
