Missed work & Late Policies

- If a student is absent from school, they are responsible for finding out what assignments were missed, and making them up.
 - Students will have work returned in as many days absent from school, plus one day. *For example, if you were gone two days and returned to school on Monday, your assignments are due no later than Wednesday.
 - Quizzes and tests can be made up at a mutually agreed upon time. If the student does not show up, they will receive a zero.
 - Students missing class for an extracurricular activity must have assignments due before leaving school for the activity. Homework assigned the day class was missed must be turned in on the due date.
 - Late work will go in the gradebook as a zero until handed in, unless an extension is arranged before the due date. Late work will be accepted until the end of the quarter, anything after will result in a zero. The maximum score possible for late work is 70%.
- Bell ringers and exit tickets will be used daily to warm up and give a quick synopsis of student learning. Weekly homework helps students practice the skills they have learned within the classroom. Classroom time will be given for assignments, students should take advantage of this time to reduce the need to do work outside the classroom.

Smaller quizzes will occur during the unit, while tests will be given at the end of the unit. A semester exam will be given worth 10% of the semester grade.

Classroom Policies:

- Learning can be a vulnerable experience, our classroom will not function properly if all members do not treat each other with respect and compassion.
- All parties participating in cheating will earn a zero. Just do your work.
- Phones are not to be seen, or heard, in my classroom. If they are seen, they will be taken according to school policies.
- You have four minutes to get to class, fill your water, go to the bathroom, and talk with your friends. Please be in the classroom, ready to learn, when the bell rings. Students who are tardy will serve detention, before or after school. You have one week from the day you were tardy to make up the detention before more time is added.
