Objective

Students will learn and improve their ability to read, write, listen, and speak in the English language through a variety of historical topics.

Classroom Expectations

- **Be respectful**

 - Use English to the best of your ability in class. Do not be afraid of making mistakes or asking questions. Practicing English as much as possible will help you get better.

Technology

Technology use including phones, iPads, electronic watches, ear buds, etc. is not permitted during class unless needed for academic purposes or instructed by the teacher.

The iPad you use is school property and is to be used for academic purposes. Any inappropriate use of your iPad may result in the confiscation of your iPad.

The use of artificial intelligence (AI) is not permitted in the classroom unless instructed or approved by the teacher for specific purposes. The use of AI may inhibit your pace of improvement in language. Any assignment found to be completed fully or partially by AI will result in a zero.

Consequences

Students who do not follow class rules including tardies or disruptive behavior, will be given the following consequences.

Verbal Warning- You will be asked once to change your behavior.

Detention- If disruptive behavior or tardiness persists, students will be given a 30 minute detention. Detentions may be served before or after school. Let your teacher know when you plan to serve your detention.

Further Action- After the accumulation of 2 detention hours not served. The student will be recommended for ISS.
